

NOTICE OF 15-DAY PUBLIC AVAILABILITY LGBT Training Requirements Date Posted: July 26, 2017

PUBLIC PROCEEDINGS: Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8(c) and Title 1 California Code of Regulations, Section 44, notice is hereby given that the California Department of Public Health (Department) has changed the text of the proposed regulations LGBT – Training Requirements, DPH-14-006, and is making the changed text available for public comment prior to adoption, amendment or repeal of the resulting regulations. The Department also revised the Fiscal Impact Analysis to conform with the revised text. The Fiscal Impact Analysis is available upon request.
